PROJECT UPDATE

US 18 (Bluemound Road) Resurfacing Project to Close Inside Lanes

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing work on the US 18 (Bluemound Road) reconstruction project between I-94 and the east Waukesha County line (approximately 124th Street). The following work is scheduled from east of Moorland Road to the eastern county line. Department contractors have completed all asphalt paving scheduled for 2023, with the following related work scheduled from east of Moorland Road to the eastern county line.

Work scheduled to begin Friday, Oct. 13th

- Traffic on US 18 is scheduled to be shifted to the inside lanes with two lanes of traffic maintained in each direction, while crews complete final pavement markings and other restoration work.
- Intermittent daytime lane closures to complete remaining work. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained during afternoon peak travel hours.

Please note that work for 2023 is scheduled to be completed in early November, with 2024 work scheduled to resume in early spring between Barker Road and Westmoor Drive.

Remaining work for 2023:

- Pavement markings
- Site restoration
- Signal installation at Underwood Crossing and 124th Street

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained throughout construction.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
